

Rules For Fabulous Florida Tour Points Calculation:

Tournament points are calculated and awarded according to the overall players' placement at the end of the tournament.

1. Each player in a tournament receives two points for playing.
2. Each player will get two additional points for every player beat.
3. For a one day tournament, the number of points halved.
4. When a tournament does not offer a players usual division, (e.g. Grand Master) the players points can be transferred to their usual division.
 - a. Points cannot be moved between Professional and Amateur divisions.
 - b. The request to move the points must be made before 30 days after the end tournament or 3 days before the start of the last FFT tournament, whichever is shorter.

Example:

Fred Rooster wins the tournament so he gets 16 points plus two for playing in the tournament.

Since Steve Smith and George Carlin are tied they get points for the 5 people they beat plus 2 for playing in the tournament.

Brian Underwood places last and gets one point for playing in the tournament.
